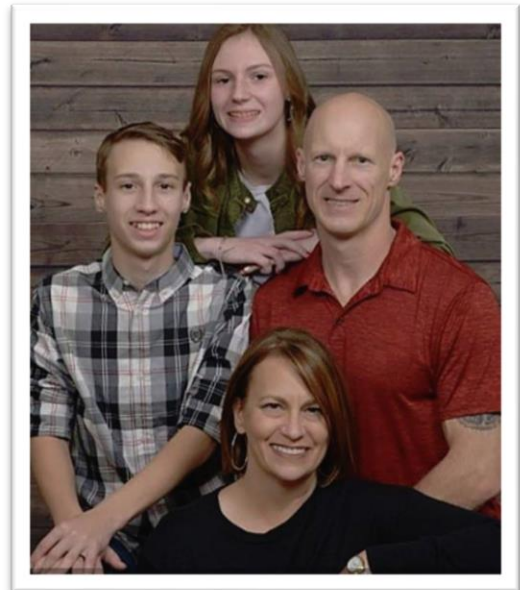

My career began in insurance and financial industries and after 25 years, it was time for a change. Three years ago, I was led to RightNow Media. It is a nice change of pace from the



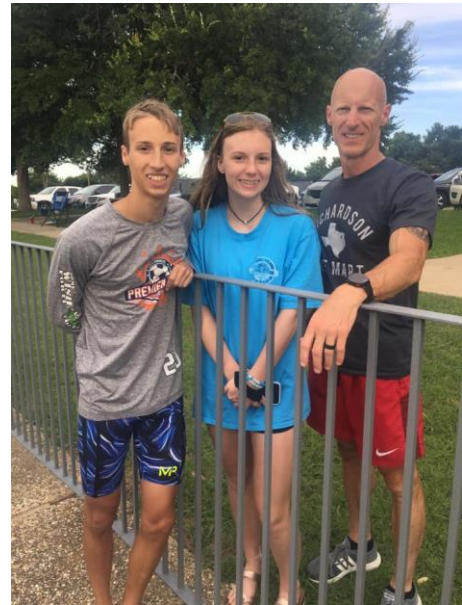
corporate world and even better, I feel as though what I do on a day-to-day basis is more important because it is part of God's mission.
